

INFORMATION ABOUT AUTHORS

Vilem Adamec (1953)

is the head of the Department of Civil Protection at the Faculty of Safety Engineering of Technical University of Ostrava. He specializes in Population Protection, Crisis Management, Integrated Rescue System, Civil Emergency Planning and Critical Infrastructure Protection.

He graduated from the Technical University of Ostrava, Faculty of Mining and Geology; Fire Protection and Industry Security Technology section (1977). He completed his doctoral studies at the Institute of Safety Engineering with a thesis on "Management of Rescue Works of Operational and Information Centres" in 2002. He habilitated at the Faculty of Safety Engineering in 2009 with a thesis "Study of Possibilities of Establishing level of Civil Emergency Preparedness of Territorial Units".

He is an author or a co-author of 16 publications, more than 30 contributions in collections of national and international conferences, 5 contributions in proceedings of international conferences abroad, more than 40 articles in national and foreign professional journals. He is also a member of several scientific councils, commissions and editorial boards of magazines.
